## OTHER WORKFORCE

This is a term to describe those positions where legislation exists to enable a criminal record check to be submitted through DBS but the primary focus of the work is not child or adult related. It is not a legislative term in itself.

**Disclaimer:** The plain English explanation which appears at the top of each section is not to be taken as the legislative purpose; it is a descriptor of the legislation in each section.

### ENHANCED level DBS certificate

**Applications by or on behalf of authorities to consider granting or renewing a licence to drive a taxi or private hire vehicle. (Not applications for taxi drivers who are entering into a contract to drive children or adults)**

Legislation

Considering the applicant's suitability to obtain or hold a licence under section 46 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847; section 8 of the Metropolitan Public Carriage Act 1869; section 9 of the Plymouth City Council Act 1975; section 51 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976; or section 13 of the Private Hire Vehicles (London) Act 1998

**Applications for criminal record checks by or on behalf of authorities to grant or renew a licence to operate premises where gambling can take place**

Legislation

Obtaining or holding an operating licence under Part 5 of the Gambling Act 2005 for the purposes of that Act

**Applications for criminal record checks by or on behalf of authorities to grant or renew a licence to individuals to operate premises where gambling can take place**

Legislation

Obtaining or holding a personal licence under Part 6 of the Gambling Act 2005 for the purposes of that Act

**Applications for criminal record checks by or on behalf of authorities when an individual applies to work for the Gambling Commission**

Legislation

Considering an individual's suitability for a position as Commissioner for the Gambling Commission and for any office or employment in the Commissioners' service

**Applications for criminal record checks by or on behalf of authorities to grant or renew a licence to a body who wishes to run the National Lottery or promote/sell tickets in relation to that Lottery**

Legislation

Obtaining or holding a licence under section 5 or 6 of the National Lottery Act 1993 (running or promoting lotteries).

**Applications for criminal record checks relating to an individual who is required to be registered by the Immigration Services Commissioner in order to provide immigration advice or services to another not in connection with criminal proceedings. This does not apply to those who work in UKBA**

Legislation

Considering the applicant's suitability for work as a person who provides immigration advice or services as defined in section 82(1) of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 and is—

- (i) a registered person under Part 5 of that Act
- (ii) a person who acts on behalf of and under the supervision of such a registered person
- (iii) a person who is exempt by section 84(4)(a) to (c) of that Act

**Applications for criminal record checks on behalf of an authority to consider granting or renewing a licence to an organisation or persons within that organisation where their remit is to produce, supply, offer to supply or have in his possession any controlled drug, in the course of their duties**

Legislation

Considering the applicant's suitability to obtain or retain a licence under regulation 5 of the Misuse of Drugs Regulations 2001 or under Article 3(2) of Regulation 2004/273/EC or under Article 6(1) of Regulation 2005/111/EC where the question relates to any person who as a result of his role in the body concerned is required to be named in the application for such a licence (or would have been so required if that person had had that role at the time the application was made)

**Applications for criminal record checks relating to assessing an individual's suitability to possess, remove or transfer a weapon or ammunition, to or from others when acting as an armed guard on UK ships**

Legislation

Considering an individual's suitability to have in their possession, to acquire or to transfer prohibited weapons or ammunition to which section 5 of the Firearms Act applies

**Applications for criminal records checks where the organisation needs to assess if someone is suitable to carry out a role where the work is for National Security purposes**

Legislation

Assessing the suitability of a person for any office or employment which relates to national security

**Standard level DBS certificate**

**Any work that is not related to working with children or adults that is eligible for a standard level certificate by virtue of its inclusion in the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 (Exceptions) Order 1975**
